## MISSION PARTNER Focus

### Mohan and Moses Cross Mission, India

*Mohan established Zion Gospel Ministries, now known as Cross Mission, to glorify God by preaching the gospel, making disciples and planting churches among the unreached people groups of India.*

#### Praise points:

1. For the completed construction of Magatapalli Church dedicated to God's glory. The Church, which took more than three years to build, can accommodate 1,000 people and will serve as a central place of worship for the community and can act as a shelter during times of emergencies
2. For the Dedication Ceremony of the new Church attended by more than 2,000 people from the villages
3. For 10 new baptisms and for the joy in the 'washing feet ceremony' in all the main Church plants

#### Please pray for:

1. The believers to grow in faith in all the Churches and that the

children, including those of Hindu background, who attended the Vacation Bible School will trust God and come to a living faith in Christ

2. The vision God is putting in the hearts of Mohan and Moses: 'Disciples making disciples and Churches planting churches' and pray for wisdom as they organise and restructure the whole ministry of Cross Mission
3. Good health and protection for all the Christian pastors in the face of rising Hindu fundamentalism and restrictions in Christian witness
4. The granting of FCRA (Foreign Contribution Regulation Act) applied for by Mohan many months ago, and now required by the government to allow donations from overseas
5. The leadership of Cross Mission so that they can train more pastors in the next two years and for the pastors who have completed their training.
