The house that All Saints built . . .

Caminul Felix is a Romanian charity which re-homes orphaned children into family units headed by Christian parents. It is based in Oradea and All Saint's relationship with it goes back around 20 years. When those children grow up and get married the charity wants to be able to help in any tangible way it can, just like those of us who are parents do for our children.

The house that 37 people from All Saints have helped to build this year is one such example. It's a starter family home built at cost and Elena and Robbie Muntean have now entered into a mortgage to pay back this cost to CF. As someone who is, frankly, a little worse than useless at DIY, I was nervous about my part in building a house. However the role of our working parties was no more than manual labouring – and that suited me fine; being told what to do all week was very refreshing actually! As well as the awesome reality of building a house in just three weeks we were hosted by the large (and

varying) families each evening for dinner. This was a real privilege as we were able to see the beating heart of CF in action. Sincere and caring parents just giving kids a second chance at being a family.
