Dear Parents and Leaders,

I would like to inform you of precautions and measures being put in place for All Saints Kids in light of the Coronavirus pandemic.

We are committed to the safety of all our children so we are closely monitoring the situation and continuing to follow advice provided by the government and Church of England.

We expect to run a normal ASK session tomorrow. However, if you and your family have been advised to self-isolate, or if you or your child has a new continuous cough or a fever (temperature over 37.8 degrees C), then we would ask that you do not to send them to All Saints Kids.

Next week, 22nd March is Mother's Day so there is a SALT service planned with no ASK. We will be closely monitoring government advice as we consider whether our last ASK of term, 29th March will run.
