

Friday 25th August *Psalm 144:9-15*

Pray for opportunities to serve and use your gifts to support the church. With a new term around the corner ask God for wisdom as to whether there may be a new area of service or new group for you to join in the life of the church.

Saturday 26th August *Psalm 146*

Give thanks for the local businesses and community groups which bring life to Lindfield. Pray for Christians to be a witness in those groups, and that each of us may be good supporters of local business. Ask that the local traders will prosper with a good trade over the summer.

Sunday 27th August *Psalm 147:1-11*

Pray for our combined 10.30am service. Ask that as we reflect on the truths contained within some well known hymns we might be encouraged to sing them with great conviction. Pray for good fellowship between those who normally go to different services.

Monday 28th August *Psalm 147:12-22*

Pray for the Ascension church in Haywards Heath as Neil Tipple, their Vicar announced his retirement from November. Ask that he might finish well, and the

Tuesday 29th August *Psalm 148*

Pray for the Church of England, both locally and nationally. For our bishops; Martin, Mark and Richard, and our Archbishops, Justin and John. Ask that our bishops would lead the church in proclaiming the good news of Jesus and protecting the church from error. Give them great love and wisdom as they do this.

Wednesday 30th August *Psalm 149*

Pray for you neighbours; those next door or down the road, those who you see at the shop, the gym or the surgery. Ask that your life and words might be compelling to them. Pray for opportunities to share the hope you have.

Thursday 31st August *Psalm 150*

As our readings from the Psalms conclude, join with the Psalmist in giving praise to God! Look back over the last month and consider all the different things for which you have to praise God for.

Tuesday 1st August *Amos 5:6-15*

Pray for Tiger at Ten meeting this morning.

Wednesday 2nd August *Amos 5:18-27*

Pray for families away on holidays or holidaying at home. Pray for safety, rest and quality time together. Ask that where there are tensions between spouses and other family members, that love and peace will rule.

Thursday 3rd August *Amos 6:1-7*

Pray for today's holiday fun morning with 30 children aged 0-11 coming for crafts, games and to hear more of Jesus. As we reflect on the fact the Jesus is King over everything and everyone, ask that these young people might come to love and worship Jesus themselves.

Friday 4th August *Amos 6:8-14*

Unfortunately the planned holiday club had to be cancelled due to lack of people - in light of that, please pray for Penny Hollebbon that she would be encouraged despite

this. Pray that we might still have opportunities to share the good news with primary school children.

Saturday 5th August *Amos 7:1-9*

Following on from 'Fellowship July' ask that as a church family and across smaller groups we may continue to grow in love for one another, to show hospitality and practical service and that our fellowship may shape us all to be more like Jesus.

Sunday 6th August *Amos 7:10-17*

Pray for our weekly 8am services. Ask that the regularity over the summer would increase the faith and fellowship of that congregation.

Monday 7th August *Amos 8:1-8*

Tuesday 8th August *Amos 8:9-14*

today. Give thanks for Rachel's time in Lindfield and especially for the way she has helped to serve the Cornerstone congregation with her singing. Pray for their wedding day and their new life together.

Sunday 13th August *Psalms 107:23-32*

Give thanks for Ice Cream Sunday, ask that families both in our church and community would feel welcomed and able to join in the fun and worship. Ask that for some it might be a great introduction to church.

Tuesday 15th August *Psalms 110*

Sunday 20th August *Psalms 119:1-16*

Give thanks for our Cornerstone service, especially for the young people who make it their fellowship. Ask that the summer Psalms series might cause us all to want to sing of our great God.

Pray for Cavan Wood, James Clarke, Chris Steynor and Hugh Bourne speaking at our services today. Pray also for Hugh leading a communion service at Horsted Keynes.

Monday 21st August *Psalms 121*

Pray for Jonny Payne starting soon as our new Youth Pastor. Ask that he may settle well into the area and into the All Saints family. Pray for all the practicalities of moving and setting up home to go smoothly. Ask that he may quickly get to know young people and their parents here.
