Their aim is to support parents as they try to ensure that their children have the best start in life – “A strong family for every child in Sussex”.

Alongside emotional and financial support, FSW also provides food parcels, clothing, household goods and help with winter fuel bills where necessary. It also runs a number of family activities and children’s clubs both in and out of term time.
